## YOUTH CAMP MEETING

**Napetet**-In April, August, and December, the schools in Kenya are closed. We hold a camp meeting for the youth and invite all of our churches to one location. This month, it was at Napetet. Over 100 youth attended with many walking over 60kms (2 days). It was a great time of teaching, preaching, food, and fun. Each choir presented a number of songs. The pastors and I shared in the teaching and preaching. **There were 14 salvations and many decisions to commit their lives to Christ.** They are so hungry for the Word. Each teaching went over in time because there were so many questions. My last session was supposed to be only 1 hour, but it continued for 4! Most of the questions were cultural and I learned a lot about the ways of the Turkana. It is important to me that I give a completely Biblical answer and not teach MY culture. I want Christian Turkana, not American Turkana.

## THE DEVIL AND HIS MEN

**Natiir**-I reported in March 2007 that a man had come to this village and told them I was a devil worshiper. I spoke against the accusation and convinced them I was a man of God. They welcomed me and my men to come and teach them the Word of God. Then I went to America on furlough. In my absence, the same man returned and was surprised to see my men laboring in the village. He brought yet another accusation. Shortly after my last visit, a young boy in the village died. **The man told them the reason the boy died was because I drank his blood** and that upon my return, I would want to drink more blood from their children! My men did not know what to do. They refuted the rumor and were welcomed to continue their Biblical teaching. I went out to see the village this month and confronted them about this rumor and its source. They said they knew the report was not true...but they just did not have anything else to believe. Many in Natiir have accepted Christ and want to be baptized. They have been studying the Bible for over two years and God has grown them to the point where they desire to be a church. So in spite of all the devil and his men have tried to do, God has given victory and a church will soon be planted. Please continue to pray for Natiir as they are still young in their faith.
