### CRUSADES

**Naduat**-All of our Pastors travelled with me at the invitation of Josephat who is leading this Bible Study. We held a 3 day crusade. This involves hours of hut-to-hut evangelism, preaching, teaching, and the Jesus film. 15 were saved during this time, young faith was strengthened, and solid steps were taken in our plans to baptize and organize in August.

**Nakechichok**-Pastor David invited Pastor Michael and I to come and help in a 3 day crusade in his village. We taught lessons one full day to a packed house (pictured below), showed the Jesus film, and evangelized. It was a joy to see 7 receive Christ, including Mzee Paulo, my African dad...*joy unspeakable and full of glory! 1 Ptr 1:8*

### SALVATIONS & BAPTISMS

**Napetet**-Evangelism & preaching are 2 things this church is faithful to do each and every week because of the heart of Pastor Michael. It led to 17 receiving Christ as Savoir and baptizing another 9.

**Kalokol**-With a full church (nearly 100) each week, Pastor Steven is doing a fine job. This month, there were 5 saved and 6 baptized.

**Nanyangakipi**-Pastor Peter has restarted evangelism efforts in this village. 4 were saved on Valentine's Day!  
**Nakechichok**-Pastor David is a huge blessing to me. He works hard and loves the Lord. But his church is having a problem. I went out 2 Sundays to try and help find a solution. His church has 12 benches...or room for 100 packed folks. With numbers reaching 150...people are sitting outside along the building just to hear the Word of God! Praise the Lord! 14 were saved this month.

**Nangolipus**-This church is finally taking strong root and the elders are beginning to come. Pastor Moses is very young but is maturing in his faith. There were 3 that made professions of faith this month. Please pray for Moses and this church.

**Naduat**-51 salvations in this mining village! During our crusade effort, one of the mines collapsed, burying 6 men. 5 were rescued alive! Josephat has such a heart for these folks. Please pray for Naduat.

### BUILDING

**Nangolipus**-I finally fulfilled my part of the construction at this church. We began in December, and finished this month by installing double doors and smaller posts. The members can now nail the mirara (palm branches) they have cut to close in the building.

**I Can Not Believe** I was sick with malaria again. While I lay in bed recovering, I reread *The Journals of Jim Elliot*. He asked a question of himself that spoke so strongly to me; I would like to pose it to you..."Are you willing to lie in some native hut to die of a disease American doctors never heard of?"
