LBBI

Lodwar-The students in the "Upendo" class began the first of a 2 part survey of the Old Testament. It was such a joy for me to study and teach...and I like to think it was the same for the students? All passed their exams with near perfect marks! I praise the Lord for the progress of these men. Please continue to pray for them as they have reached the half way point in the Basic level of our Bible Institute.

SALVATIONS

Napetet-This month, our church in this village saw 11 make professions of faith. The Turkwel River is still dry as the number awaiting baptism grows.

Nakechichok-There were 3 saved this month and we continue to wait for water in the Turkwel River.

Nanyangakipi-5 put their faith in Jesus Christ this month and there are now 14 that want to be baptized as soon as there is water.

Nangolipus-7 made professions of faith this month. There is a thriving new business that has followed the road that was built by our church members so that I could get in and out of this village with my truck. Before they welcomed the Gospel, the only access to them was by foot...for about 20kms. Now because of the road, fishermen are able to sell their catch. They have pushed all the way to the Lake. So we were able to baptize in this village...but we had to watch out for the crocodiles!! This month, 14 followed the Lord in obedience to baptism.

Naduat-26 souls were saved and we continue to teach our way through Bible doctrine. I thank God for the help of our Pastors who are willing to go with me and work "throughout all Judea".

Kalokol-Through teaching Bible in 2 different high schools in this village, there were 18 students who made professions of faith. We baptized 7 of those in our this month.

Kapoeta-Missionary John Wanyonyi invited me and our Turkana Pastors to come this month and help in the work in South Sudan. I was not able to go, but I helped send Pastors Michael & Steven. The Turkana men have an advantage over others who might go...the Tuposu share the same language as the Turkana. Through their time and efforts in this village, there were 21 that were saved. Please pray for the work in South Sudan, for Missionary John as he labors there, and for us as we pray for opportunities to return and help in this work.

LEADERSHIP SEMINAR

Nanyangakipi-Pastor Peter and Nanyangakipi Landmark Baptist Church invited all our other churches in the District to come and participate in a Leadership Seminar. With new churches, young pastors, and a wide range of age in our membership...it was beneficial to bring everyone together to understand each other's role in the church. I also took advantage of this opportunity to explain in a large view what my role is as their missionary. It was eye opening to listen to their answers when asked what the duties were for a missionary, pastor, and church leader. It revealed areas of weaknesses and many areas of strength. I am thankful for the unity and sweet fellowship between each of our churches and their pastors. God has blessed me with great brothers in Turkana: Pastor Michael from Napetet, Pastor Steven from Kalokol, Pastor Peter from Nanyangakipi, Pastor David from Nakechichok, Pastor Moses from Nangolipus, and Pastor Josephat from Naduat. Please pray for them, their families, and their churches.
